- The parties mutually agree to this amendment as follows. All actions noted below are by this reference made a part of the Agreement and incorporated herein:

A. This amendment incorporates the following changes, Subject CALNET 2, MSA 1 (AT&T):


- This amendment shall extend the CALNET 2 - Module 1 Contract between The State of California, and AT&T for a period of Two (2) years. The Original Term defined in CALNET2, General Provisions, Section 81 was from 01/30/07 – 01/29/14. The Extended Term under CALNET2, General Provisions, Section 81 will be from 01/30/07 – 01/29/16.
- The commencement of the Disentanglement (Transition-Out) period defined in CALNET2, General Provisions, Section 77 shall begin 1/30/14 and shall run through 7/29/15. A six (6) month period beginning 07/30/15 through 01/29/16 is provided for the State to complete competitive procurements for CALNET2 services not currently offered on CALNET3.

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This Agreement is effective January 30, 2014, or upon Department of Technology - approval, whichever is later.

All other terms and conditions of the original agreement shall remain the same with the exception of the verblage noted above.

3. During the Disentanglement (Transition-Out) period described in subparagraph 2 above, CALNET 2 contract services shall be continued for: Service Categories previously selected by a customer and under which customer is receiving CALNET 2 contract services as of January 29, 2014 (adds, moves and changes within such Service Categories will be allowed per the terms of CALNET 2); (ii) New customer orders for E911 Services; and (iii) Any CALNET 2 service not available on CALNET 3 at the time the customer order is placed. Consistent with subparagraph 2 above, during the last six months of the Extended Term, 7/30/2015 – 1/29/2016, CALNET 2 contract services shall only be continued for: (i) New customer orders for E911 Services; and (ii) Any CALNET 2 service not available on CALNET 3 at the time the customer order is placed.
4. CALNET2, Exhibit A-2 and A-6 Authorization to Order; A-2 Terms of Paragraph 4 & 5, and A-6 Paragraph 4 shall not be applicable for terminations taking place after January 29, 2014.
5. CALNET2, General Provisions, Section 70. "Most Favored Nation" Status of State shall not be applicable for CALNET2 after January 29, 2014.
