- The parties mutually agree to this amendment as follows. All actions noted below are by this reference made a part of the Agreement and incorporated herein:

This amendment shall extend the CALNET 2 – MSA 3 Contract between the State of California, and Verizon for a period of two (2) years.

Original Term: 01/30/2007 – 01/29/2016
 New Term: 01/30/2007 – 01/29/2018

This amendment incorporates the following changes:

- CALNET 2 services will only be available for those services that are not available on CALNET 3.
- CALNET 2 Cable and Wire Services:
 - No new cable and wire service orders may be submitted or accepted after January 29, 2017.
 - Implementation and invoicing of all cable and wire services must be completed by January 29, 2018.
 - Section 6.3.8.1.2 Station Wiring
 - Attachment 3 – Feature Name and Feature Description change for Feature ID CPDS0000, Station Cabling Premise Distribution, 2 pages.
 - Attachment 4 – Feature Name change for Feature ID CPDS0000, Station Cabling Premise Distribution, 2 pages.

3. CALNET 2 NG 9-1-1 Routing Services:
 - a. New orders for NextGen Emergency Routing Service can be placed through the period of time that allows completion of implementation by January 29, 2018. Verizon reserves the right to refuse an order if Verizon reasonably determines that implementation and migration to a new vendor cannot be completed by January 29, 2018, with concurrence of the Department of Technology (CDT), which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
 - b. Invoicing must occur within 60 calendar days after contract expiration. Such invoices shall be paid within 45 calendar days of receipt of invoice(s) in accordance with GC 927 (b).
 - c. Internet Dedicated Access in support of NG 9-1-1 Routing Service will be available on CALNET 2 for the duration of the contract or until migration is complete to another contract, whichever occurs first.
4. CALNET 2 Equipment:
 - a. Equipment shall be ordered, received, and invoiced no later than January 29, 2018.
 - b. Section 6.3.9 Converged Services, Required Customer Premise Equipment (CPE):
 - i. Attachment 3 has been modified to include Pre-Implementation and Implementation services, 75 pages.
 - ii. Attachment 4 has been modified to include Pre-Implementation and Implementation services, 18 pages.
5. This two (2) year contract extension encompasses the Disentanglement period as set forth in Section 77 and no disentanglement obligations shall remain beyond January 29, 2018.
6. The parties agree that all requirements in the Agreement for Verizon to maintain and/or administer a public and private web site (including networks, systems and devices supporting the CALNET 2 public and private website) shall not apply to Verizon after Verizon has provided access to CALNET 2 Product Catalog, Fiscal Reporting, Service Level Agreement Reporting, and invoices at the Verizon Enterprise Center web portal or by any other means mutually agreed to between Verizon and STND.

All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.
