



## What's New in CA OM WebViewer V12

Many of you have been waiting for some of the added functionality of this new release of the Web Viewer.

Here are some highlights of what is new:

<b>LOGIN:</b>	Use only your RACF ID and Password. The generic LOGONIDS that used to point you to your database are obsolete. (ex.: GCONLINE, or EQONLINE, etc.)
<b>Advanced Search:</b>	This TAB takes you to a page where you can select the database that has your reports.
<b>Group Admins:</b>	Agency personnel who have more control over Web Viewer settings and may customize for their users. Group Admins may control what functions their USERS can perform and what they can see. Group Admins must add new USERS to the appropriate ROLE.
<b>Active/X</b>	There is a new Active/X control that needs to be downloaded for V12. If you have ADMIN rights to your PC, this should happen automatically, when you initiate PRINT. If not, your Go Online Group Administrator will need to push Active/X to your machine. This control is needed for more advanced functions such as PRINT and EXPORT. The new Active/X control file is ERMHelper2AX.
<b>PRINT</b>	You can now specify page range selections, separated by commas to print more specific pages.
<b>EXPORT</b>	Export now has a more comprehensive selection criteria dialog that allows you to be more specific in including and excluding lines. There are TABS for Loading Rules, Saving Rules, manipulating columns, specifying page ranges, etc. See the User's Guide or the Online Help for more information.
<b>TIMEOUT</b>	The TIMEOUT value has been increased to 30 minutes of inactivity. The old value was 20 minutes.



<b>ROLES</b>	Agency Group Administrators can group USERS into ROLES that permit USERS to performs certain functions or only see certain reports. He can limit functions such as emailing, saving, printing, exporting, etc.
<b>CONFIGURATION</b>	The CONFIGURATION tab allows you to change your ROLE and Default Access to another ROLE for different access and testing purposes.
<b>SECURITY</b>	The controls that the V12 Web Viewer uses are a layer on top of the access that is provided by RACF on the mainframe. Mainframe security still determines what reports and access are available to each user. If you don't have mainframe access to a resource, you won't have access in the Web Viewer, regardless of the new settings.
<b>SOFTWARE</b>	The V12 application is written in JAVA for portability. Before logging on, be sure to request a new session in your browser (File>New Session) and then logoff gracefully to avoid Internet Explorer session problems.
<b>SUBSCRIPTIONS</b>	<p>One of the key features of CA OM Web Viewer is the subscription method of report access. Subscriptions (bundles of reports, report sections, or search filters designated as Favorites) are a new concept introduced in CA Output Management Web Viewer Version 12.0.</p> <p><i>A Subscription is a group of favorites that has been given a name and description. The Subscription name can now be used by Administrators and Advanced Users to assign this bundle of reports to one or more Roles. Only Advanced Users and Administrators can create Subscriptions, and only Administrators can assign the Subscriptions to other Roles. With a Subscription, you can access reports without having to keep track of which repositories contain which reports. You do not have to search a repository every time you want to find the report</i></p>
