CALNET

The vision, strategy and policy for procuring and implementing telecommunications and network services on a statewide basis are through the four modules of the CALNET Master Services Agreements (MSA) awarded on January 30, 2007.

The four modules of the CALNET MSA cover a five-year term through January 29, 2012, and included an option for two (2) one-year extensions.

The four modules of the CALNET MSA for telecommunications services are:

Module 1: Voice, Data and Video Services

Module 2: Long Distance and Network Based Services

Module 3: Internet Protocol (IP) Voice, Data and Video Services

Module 4: Broadband Fixed Wireless Access (BFWA) Data Services

Agencies can purchase **mandatory services** directly from the contract, with the confidence that all government requirements for competitive bidding have been met. Other contract vehicles may also be utilized as resources for state and local agencies to purchase and implement telecommunications services not available on the CALNET MSA.
